What is EYFS ?

Communication and Language, Physical development, Personal, Social and Emotional Development The Yearly Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) sets standards for the learning, development and care of your child from birth to 5 years old. The EYFS includes the seven areas of learning and development.

The three prime areas,

Communication and Language

Physical Development

Personal, Social and Emotional development these are crucial for igniting children's curiosity and enthusiasm for learning.

Literacy

Mathematics

Understanding the world

Expressive arts and design

In the educational literature, there are suggestions about what a child may be doing and how parents and practitioners can help them but it's important to remember that children develop in different ways and at different rates

Key person approach:

Your child will have a key person. Key person is the named practitioner who has responsibilities for the small group of children, to help the child to feel safe and secure. You can get daily feedback and share any concerns related to your child

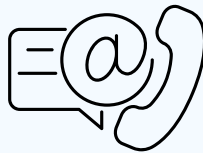

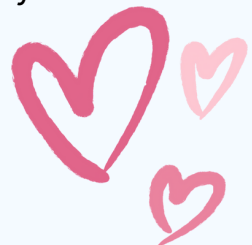
